General Motors will launch the new Chevrolet Captiva in India after the launch of the Beat Diesel. The American automaker will offer the new Captiva with more features along with a new design. Power of the 2012 **Chevrolet Captiva** is expected to get a slight boost as well with torque levels also being increased. Just like the current version, there will be no petrol engine on offer and the Captiva will get a new 2.2 liter common rail motor which will also debut in the Cruze later.
