Hyundai Raises i20 Production



Hyundai Motor India Ltd is increasing its production gradually to meet the demand for its recently launched [Hyundai i20](#). The company has begun working an extra hour or two daily to produce more cars.

"We are working two shifts and it may not be possible for us to add a complete shift immediately. But since last few days we have increased our production by an hour or two. This helps us to make some more cars," Hyundai Motor's Senior Vice-President, Mr Arvind Saxena said.

Hyundai, which expected to sell 2,000 units of its i20 on an average on a monthly basis, received an order of 2,500 units last month. Of this, the company delivered 1,700 and the remaining will be handed over to customers this month.
